

TORBAY FULLBORE CLUB CHAIRMANS CUP COMPETITION

This competition is shot at the 25 yard Denbury range with any .22 Rimfire rifle, while in the standing position. Any rest can be used. Any sights are allowed.

This competition can be shot at any time during the competition season (competition season ends on 30th September) and can be entered once for each eligible rifle you have.

The course of fire:

20 rounds in total. Fire 5 rounds at each of the 4 outer targets while in the standing position and using any rest. The centre target can be used as a sighting target.

The size of the 5 round group which has been shot at each of the 4 outer targets is measured in millimetres, these 4 group sizes are added together and then divided by 4 to produce an average. The winning score is the target with the smallest group.

How to participate in this competition:

1. Get a target. The target is shown below. Ensure it is the correct target as it is a new target for 2026. The target identification is **10 metre Air Rifle AIR 3/89** and is **circled in red** on the target shown below. The targets are located in the 'Competitions targets' box in the range box or ask the Range officer.
2. **PRINT** your details on the target – name, date and Firearm used. Stating the firearm used will help you prove usage of your firearms in competitions and is also needed if multiple entries with different eligible firearms are made.
3. Shoot the target! Following the course of fire explained above.
4. Once shot, put your competition target in the 'Competition targets for scoring' box in the range box or give it to the Range officer. Competition results will be posted on the Club Facebook page and Website.

A prize will be awarded for 1st place and will be announced in due course.
