

TORBAY FULLBORE CLUB DENBURY PISTOL COMPETITION

This competition is shot at the 25 yard Denbury range with any Pistol or Revolver i.e. Long Barrel Pistol / Revolver, Muzzle Loading Pistol / Revolver using Nitro or Black powder. Any calibre can be used i.e. .22 Rimfire, .38 Special, .357 Magnum, .44 Magnum etc. for cartridge Pistols / Revolvers and .36, .38, .357, .44, .45 calibre etc. for Muzzle loading Pistols / Revolvers. The Competition is shot in the standing unsupported position using one or two hands to grip the Pistol / Revolver. Any sights are allowed.

This competition can be shot at any time during the competition season (competition season ends on 30th September) and can be entered once for each eligible Pistol you have.

The course of fire:

10 rounds in total. Fire 10 rounds at the target while in the standing, unsupported position using one or two hands to grip the Pistol / Revolver

Each hit on the target is worth 10 points, with a maximum of 100 points possible. The highest score wins.

How to participate in this competition:

1. Get a target. The target identification number is **U.I.T 50m & 25m PRECISION PISTOL TARGET PL 15 -18**, this is printed on the top righthand side of the target and **circled in Red** on the target shown below. The targets are located in the 'Competitions targets' box in the range box or ask the Range officer.
2. **PRINT** your details on the target – name, date and Firearm used. Stating the firearm used will help you prove usage of your firearms in competitions and is also needed if multiple entries with different eligible firearms are made.
3. Shoot the target! Following the course of fire explained above.
4. Once shot, put your competition target in the 'Competition targets for scoring' box in the range box or give it to the Range officer. Competition results will be posted on the Club Facebook page and Website.

A prize will be awarded for 1st place and will be announced in due course.
