

TORBAY FULLBORE CLUB WESTWARD CUP COMPETITION

This competition is shot at the 100 yard Parracombe range with any rifle which is chambered in a centre fire rifle calibre, i.e. .223 Remington, .308 Winchester, 6.5mm Creedmore, .22-250 Remington etc. It can be shot in any position and any sights are allowed.

This competition can be shot at any time during the competition season (competition season ends on 30th September) and can be entered once for each eligible rifle you have.

The course of fire:

10 rounds in total. Fire 10 rounds at the target while in any position.

Each hit on the target is worth 10 points, with a maximum of 100 points possible. The highest score wins.

How to participate in this competition:

1. Get a target. There is a new target for this competition for the 2026 season, the target to be used is the **10 Metre Air Pistol AIR 4/89**, this is printed on the top righthand side of the target and **circled in Red** on the target shown below. You are encouraged to collect your targets that are to be shot at the Parracombe range from the Denbury range to avoid disappointment, as the Range officer may not have enough targets available on the day. The targets are located in the 'Competitions targets' box in the range box at the Denbury range or ask the Range officer.
2. **PRINT** your details on the target – name, date and Firearm used. Stating the firearm used will help you prove usage of your firearms in competitions and is also needed if multiple entries with different eligible firearms are made.
3. Shoot the target! Following the course of fire explained above.
4. Once shot, put your competition target in the 'Competition targets for scoring' box in the range box at the Denbury range or give it to the Range officer. Competition results will be posted on the Club Facebook page and Website.

A prize will be awarded for 1st place and will be announced in due course.
